HELPFUL TIPS TO MINIMISE WASTE, MAXIMISE PRINT SPEED

Today's garment decorators expect more from their equipment. And the Brother GTX Pro direct to garment printer delivers. Sure, you'll get outstanding print quality, but you'll also save time and supplies with a machine that's ready to work when you are and can output prints at industrial production level speeds. With this automated functionality built into the GTX Pro, you'll spend less time preparing the machine and more time printing.

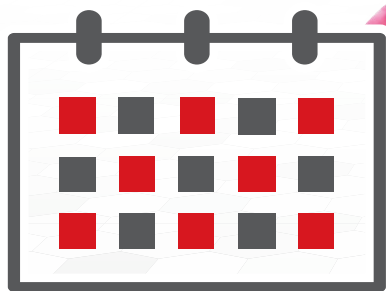


Here's how to get the most out of your GTX Pro

#1

Print on select days based on your production needs.

On days you are not printing, you don't need to do anything.

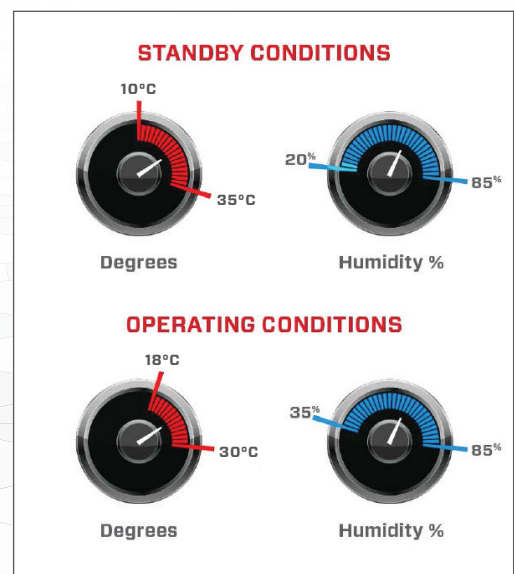


Note: The GTX Pro was designed to sit idle for up to 7 days without wasting any ink. Just keep the GTX Pro printer powered on so it can do the recirculation process.

#2

Control your environment.

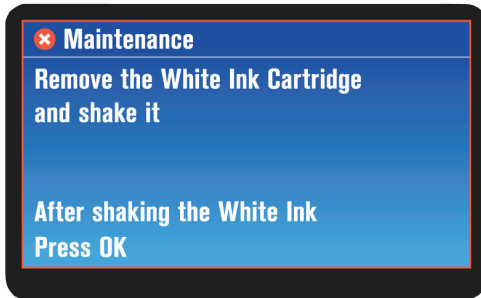
Keeping your printer in ideal ranges for temperature and humidity prior to printing will minimise the volume of any automatic cleanings.



#3

On printing days, wait to agitate the white ink or perform a parts exchange (wiper clean, fan filter and basic cleaning) until you are ready to print.

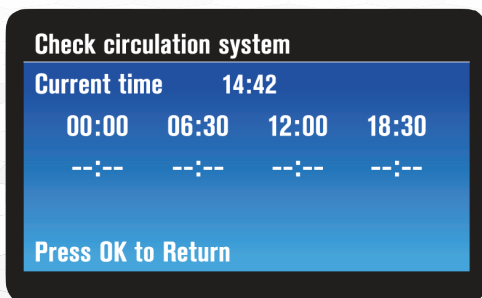
Once you agitate the white ink and press the buttons on the control panel, GTX Pro will perform a cleaning to make sure the nozzles are ready to print. However, there is no need to do this on days that you are not printing. The process takes approximately 5 minutes to complete. This is approximately the same amount of time it would take for your heat press to warm up.



#4

Print on select days based on your production needs.

If you take lunch at 12:00pm, set the schedule to 6:30am > 12:00pm > 6:30pm > 12:00am to the process happens during traditionally non-working hours.



#5

Pre-treatment

Pre-treatment can vary from garment to garment and colour to colour. Always print a test print to ensure quality.



#6

Firmware and Drivers

From time to time Brother will update Firmware and Drivers to improve the performance of your machine and add new features. Check with your dealer to ensure you are always running the latest versions.

Regular Maintenance

Keeping your machine clean and maintained is an important part of owning any garment printer. The new GTX Pro periodical part replacement notifications built in to maintain machine reliability. Please ensure you follow these guidelines. Brother recommends that your GTX Pro is professionally serviced every 25,000 prints.
